NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 read with section 10 of the Karnataka Epidemic Diseases Act, 2020 (Karnataka Act 26 of 2020) and in partial modification of earlier regulations or orders issued in this behalf to enforce COVID-19 appropriate behavior in public places like wearing mask, maintenances of social distance, restriction in the number of participants in gatherings, limiting the scope of certain activities etc., the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following Order, namely:-

ORDER

The General Public who violates to follow the Regulations / guidelines as specified in column (2) of the table below and rules issued in this behalf, the Compounding amount for violation of Regulations or guidelines and rules issued in this behalf shall be as specified in column (3) there of and the Public Servant or Officers or Officials authorised to compound the offences shall be as specified in column (4), thereof,-

1.	Compulsory wearing of mask and maintenance of social distancing. The owners of the premises shall be responsible for,- (a) ensuring compulsory wearing of mask and social distancing; (b) enforcing restrictions on the number of persons to be allowed, as follows:- (i) Marriages: 500 persons in open places; and 200 persons in closed areas. (ii) Birthday parties and other celebrations: 100 persons in open places; and 50 persons in closed areas. (iii) Death or funeral: 100 persons in open places; and 50 persons in closed areas. (iv) Cremation or burial: 50 persons. (v) Other functions: 100 persons. (vi) Religious celebrations or functions: 500 persons in open places. (vii) Political celebrations or functions: 500 persons in open places.	(i) Non air-conditioned party halls, departmental stores - Rs. 5,000/- (ii) Air conditioned party halls, departmental stores, branded shops (single and multiple brands), shopping malls - Rs. 10,000/- (iii) Starred hotels (three star and above), marriage or convention halls with a minimum capacity of five hundred persons or any other similar public places - Rs 10,000/- (iv) Organisers of public functions or rallies or gatherings or celebrations - Rs. 10,000/-	(i) In the BBMP Area,- the Marshals of Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara palike; (ii) A Police official of not below the rank of Head Constable; (iii) Health Inspectors of the Urban Local Bodies; (iv) Bill Collectors of the Urban Local Bodies; (v) Panchayat Development Officers of Gram Panchayat (vi) Secretaries of Gram Panchayat;

In case of functions, the owners of the premises as well as the organizers of the functions or hosts shall be individually responsible.
