## ORDER

Whereas, on the directions of the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, vide Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A), dated 25-11-2020 has issued guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution in the context of COVID-19 in the Country which would be in force upto 31-12-2020. Consequently, the State Government with a view to consolidate the substantial gains that have been achieved in the State against the spread of COVID-19, and to fully overcome the pandemic, issued guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution in the context of COVID-19 in the State vide Order of even number dated 27.11.2020, which would be in force upto 31-12-2020.

**Now,** the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, vide Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 28-12-2020 has directed that the guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution issued vide Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 25-11-2020, will remain in force upto 31.01.2021.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers, conferred under the Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in the capacity of Chairman, State Executive Committee, hereby directs that the guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution in the context of COVID-19 issued vide Order of even number dated 27.11.2020, <u>will remain in force including and</u> <u>upto 31.01.2021</u>, for strict implementation by Commissioner BBMP, Police Commissioners, District Deputy Commissioners, Superintendents of Police and other Heads of Departments and Authorities.
