ORDER

Whereas, the steep surge in the COVID 19 cases across the State has significantly increased the demand for medical liquid oxygen in the State.

And Whereas, the State has been making all efforts to augment, mobilize and timely supply adequate liquid medical oxygen to health care facilities in the State.

And Whereas, the State vide order of even number dated 19-04-2021 has appointed Nodal Officers for supervising liquid oxygen tanker movement in the State.

And Whereas, the State vide order No. RD 158 TNR 2020 (3) dated 03-05-2021 had issued directions pertaining to furnishing day wise data on oxygen supply from refilling station to Health Care facilities and other intended beneficiaries.

And Whereas, there is a need to judiciously and efficiently utilize available liquid medical oxygen in the State, which entails meticulous monitoring of liquid medical oxygen supply chain from refilling station/point to the last mile to ensure there is no diversion for unintended purpose.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under the Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairman, State Executive Committee, hereby appoints **Shri. Munish Moudgil, IAS, Secretary to Government of Karnataka, DPAR(AR)**, as Nodal Officer to oversee supply of medical liquid oxygen from refilling station/point to the intended Health Care Facilities/other beneficiaries with immediate effect.
